



Resolution of August 28, 2024, of the University of Zaragoza, which convenes by urgent procedure public tender for the hiring of a novice researcher (category N4) by means of a temporary employment contract, with destination in School of Engineering and Architecture.

In accordance with point 2.3 of the Equality Plan of the University of Zaragoza, approved by Agreement of 23 February 2016 of the Governing Council of the University of Zaragoza, a maximum of 1.5 points out of 100 will be added to the total score obtained in the assessment of the merits obtained from those who have had a pregnancy leave or maternity or paternity leave in the three years prior to the call.
